The Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy will be conducting the following course:

SCHOOL SHOOTINGS: THE PREVENTION, RESPONSE AND RESOLUTION OF SCHOOL SHOOTINGS IN AMERICA

This dynamic course is perhaps the best of its kind in America. Today school shootings have become cultural, social and criminal phenomena in the United States. For example, from February 8 to 14, 2008, students in such diverse places as Baton Rouge Louisiana, Memphis, Tennessee, Oxnard, California and DeKalb, Illinois were shot and killed by their peers.

The topics for this course include, Prevention Strategies, the History of School Shootings, Internal Response, Classroom Survival, Entertainment or Murder (the affects of media and video games on school shooters) External Response and Resolution (post event decision making). The course includes extensive review of case studies such as Columbine, Virginia Tech, Beslan, Russia, Thurston High School in Springfield Oregon, Case Western University and several high profile incidents where the plots were foiled. The training will be interactive, encompass table top exercises, animation and role playing scenarios.

Although prevention strategies are known to work they have little impact upon shooting incidents once they begin. Moreover a greater number of plots have been uncovered than ever before. Many of these included "groups" of students who want to imitate the Columbine and Virginia Tech massacres but are focused on setting record in numbers students killed. It's also important to recognize that terrorists have attacked schools and continue to plan to do so in the future.

This training is designed to bring together multiple disciplines to enhance the learning experience of each participant. As such a broad based group of professionals from law enforcement, education, fire and EMS, school nurses and psychologists, negotiators, juvenile court systems representatives, dispatchers, government representatives, teachers and students are encouraged to attend.
