

Closed Point of Dispensing Site (CPOD) for First Responders

Summit County Public Health, in conjunction with representatives from the five designated CPOD sites for first responders, have developed plans for the dispensing of prophylactic antibiotics to first responders and their immediate family members in the event of a biological event such as an anthrax exposure or plague outbreak. During a biological event, all first responders should report to his/her assigned CPOD site to receive prophylactic antibiotics from the Summit County pharmaceutical cache designated for this purpose.

A POD site can be classified as “Closed” or “Open”. The designation of “Closed” for these sites indicates that these sites will NOT be available to the public or people not defined as a first responders or the immediate family member of a first responder. Summit County first responders and their immediate family members will be among the first people to receive prophylactic antibiotics. The public will attend Open/Public PODS to receive prophylactic antibiotics which will be supplied from the Strategic National Stockpile approximately 24-36 hours after the request is made to the Centers for Disease Control.

All first responders should know which site they have been assigned to receive antibiotics. Please share this information with your personnel.

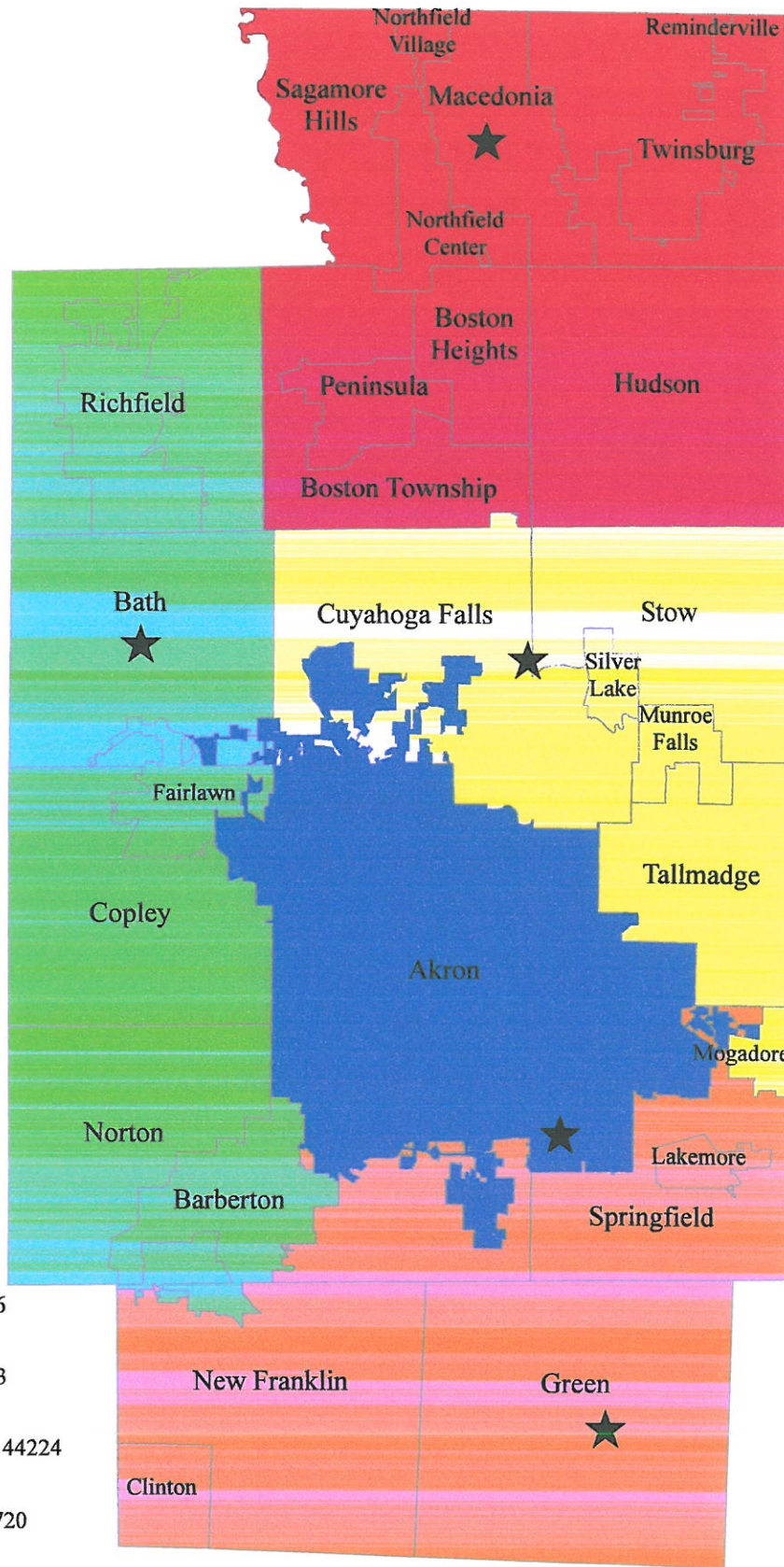
